



New Title for Manufactured and Mobile Homes

The following steps must be completed to obtain a new title for manufactured homes and mobile homes.

Step 1: Verify All Taxes Are Paid

- Verify with the Treasurer's office that all manufactured home taxes are paid in full.
- You can contact the Treasurer's office by phone at (614) 525-3438 or online at: <http://treasurer.franklincountyohio.gov>
- If the manufactured home is eligible for the Homestead tax credit, please complete the DTE 101 form and bring it with the title to the Franklin County Auditor's office. You can find the DTE 101 form online at: www.franklincountyauditor.com

Step 2: Present Title In-Person at the Auditor's Office

- You must present the title in-person to the Franklin County Auditor's office Transfer & Conveyance department, located at 373 S. High Street, 19th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
 - Hours: Monday – Friday, 9:00am – 12:00pm and 1:00pm – 4:00pm
 - A Transfer and Conveyance fee must be paid unless the transfer is exempt.
 - Transfer fees are \$0.50 and the Conveyance Fee is \$3.00 per thousand dollars, of the purchase price. You can calculate your fee using the Transfer & Conveyance Fee Calculator located on the Auditor's office website: <https://audr-apps.franklincountyohio.gov/calc/conveyancefee>
- The Auditor's office will verify all taxes are paid and complete the required Transfer and Conveyance forms before stamping the title for transfer.

Step 3: Treasurer's Office Validation Stamp

- The Auditor's office will work with the Treasurer's office to affix a red validation stamp if all taxes are paid in full.

Step 4: Franklin County Title Services (614)525-3090

- Once you have received your Transfer and Conveyance stamp and Treasurer's stamp, proceed to one of the following Franklin County Title Services agencies for the new title.
 - Main/South Branch, 45 Great Southern Blvd, Columbus, Ohio 43207
 - North Branch, 220 E. Campus View Blvd. Columbus Ohio 43235
 - East Branch, 1583 Alum Creek Drive, Columbus, Ohio 43209
 - West Branch, 4153 W. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43228
- All appropriate fees must be paid before the new title is issued.

When are my taxes due?

- Taxes are due on March 1st of each year, paid to the Franklin County Treasurer. You may choose to pay the full amount on March 1st, or half on March 1st and July 31st of each year.
